In the name of the Father of the son and of the Holy Ghost, I, Adeline Maria Dural Connelly presently residing in Florence, daughter of the Rev. Peter and Cornelia Augusta Connelly both of Philadelphia United States of America having resolved ~~to~~^{to} make the following settlement of my affairs in the event of my decease do hereby give grant assign and Dispose Devise Bequeath and Bequeath to and in favour of Harry Cheyne and Francis John Gordon Barwick both writers of the Signet in Edinburgh & the acceptor and survivor of them & failing both of them to the nearest heir male of the survivor of them who shall be major and resident within the United Kingdom of Great Britain at the time as Trustees or Trustee and in trust for the ends uses and purposes after written and to the assignees of the said Trustees or Trustee all and sundry lands and heritages goods and gear and debts in general the whole estate heritable and moveable real and personal of whatever kind and wheresoever situated at present being or which shall belong to me at the time of my decease: And I do hereby nominate and appoint my above named Trustees to be Executors: Declaring that these presents are granted in trust for the ends uses and purposes and under the conditions and declarations after mentioned ~~viz~~: (first) For payment of my debts deathbed and funeral expenses and the expenses of executing this Trust (second) For payment to Monsieur l'Abbé de Villequier of fifty two boulevard d'Argenson Neuilly sur-Seine France of the sum of fifty pounds as a grateful remembrance (third) I direct my Trustees on my decease to sell and dispose of my picture "Ecc Homo" by Guido Reni (if the same is not sold by me during my life) and that in such way & for such price as my Trustees shall in their discretion think proper: and to divide the proceeds into three parts or shares one part or share thereof they shall pay over to my adopted daughter Adeline Sybil Alice Browne granddaughter of Mr. Fletcher presently of Old Court House Hampton Court London and her heirs: one part or share thereof they shall pay over to my devoted friend Marianne

Margaret Woodward living with me and her heirs:
and the remaining part or share they shall hold
for behoof of my brother Pierce Francis Connelly,
Sculptor, Florence at present residing with me in
liferent for his liferent use only declaring that the said liferent
provision hereby made in favor of my said brother shall be
purely alimentary and shall be incapable of being anti-
cipated or assigned by him to any extent or effect
or attachable by his creditors or by any kind
of diligence and on the death of my said
brother my Trustees shall pay over the Capital
of the said share to the said Adeline Sybil Alice Browne and
heirs to the extent of one half and to the said Marianne
Margaret Woodward and her heirs to the extent of the
other half (Fourth) I leave and bequeath the whole effects of a
personal nature belonging to me (other than furniture and plenishing
in my house in Florence) and the other pictures and busts be-
longing to me to the said Adeline Sybil Alice Browne and
Marianne Margaret Woodward equally between them and
(Fifth) I direct my Trustees on my decease to sell, and dispose of the
Gold cup left to me by my father and that in such way & for such
price as they in their discretion shall think proper and to
pay over the proceeds to my said brother for his absolute
use. (Sixth) I direct my Trustees to allow my said brother
Pierce Francis Connelly the use and enjoyment of the whole
furniture and plenishing in my house in Florence at
the time of my decease (Excepting the picture "Ecco Homo" and
Gold cup especially bequeathed by me) but that during his
life only declaring that my said brother shall be entitled to the
fullest use of all the articles liferented by him consistent with
a life rent and shall not be bound to replace or restore any article
or articles of a perishable nature, or to restore any of the other
articles liferented by him. And on his death I direct
the said furniture and plenishing to be divided equally
between the said Adeline Sybil Alice Browne and Marianne
Margaret Woodward and their respective heirs. (Seventh) My
Trustees shall on my death, set aside such portion of the Funds

September

forming my Trust Estate as they in their discretion shall consider necessary for securing out of the income and revenue thereof a free life rent annuity of Sixty pounds Sterling to my brother, the said Pierce Francis Connelly, if he shall survive me, exempted from all burdens and deductions (except income tax) and Government duties including Estate Duty and Legacy or Succession Duty and I direct my Trustees to pay out of the same income and Revenue of the Funds so set apart an annuity of said amount yearly and in each year of his life after my decease and that by quarterly instalments at such times as the Trustees may find convenient. Declaring that the said annuity shall be a purely alimentary provision in favor of my said brother and shall be incapable of being anticipated or assigned by him to any extent or effect or attachable by his creditors or by any kind of diligence and on the death of my said brother I direct my Trustees to pay over the Funds set aside and held by them to meet the said annuity to the said Adeline Sybil Alice Browne and her heirs & to the said Marianne Margaret Woodward and her heirs, equally, and (lastly) with regard to the residue and remainder of my means and estate I direct my Trustees to divide the same into two parts or shares and to pay over one part or share thereof to the said Adeline Sybil Alice Browne and her heirs and the other part or share to the said Marianne Margaret Woodward and her heirs. And I hereby confer upon my Trustees the fullest powers privileges and immunities belonging to said office & also power to them to appoint Factors Agents and Attorneys with suitable remuneration and in addition to the powers of investment conferred by law on Trustees I hereby expressly authorize and empower my said Trustees either to leave the whole means and estate heritable and moveable of which my trust estate may consist at the time of my death in the securities or investments in which the same are or may be then invested without liability or responsibility for loss depreciation in value or otherwise in connection therewith and to renew the said investments if they think fit, or otherwise to realize the same and invest

the proceeds thereof along with any other funds of which my trust estate may consist in inter alia the stocks, shares of any of the Scottish Banking Corporations or other securities which they may consider suitable at the time. And I reserve my own life interest of the premises and full power to alter innovate or revoke these presents either in whole or in part by any writing under my hand however imperative and I dispense with the delivery hereof: And I hereby revoke and recall all previous testamentary writings executed by me. And I consent to registration for preservation. In Witness whereof I the said Adeline Connelly have set my name this eighteenth day of August one thousand eight hundred and ninety eighth year of Our Lord J. C.
